Personal Information

We will not collect any information about you, except where it is specifically and knowingly provided by you. We may collect the following information from you via our website contact form: name and role; email address; and contact number.

If you do not provide the relevant personal information to us, we may not be able to provide you with the information you have requested.

We may share non-personal aggregate statistics (group) data about our website visitors' traffic patterns with partners or other parties. However, this will not include, and we do not sell or share, any personal information about individual users.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers within the United Kingdom. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Your Rights

Your personal data is protected in the UK by the Data Protection Act 1998 & the 2018 GDPR regulations. The Act insures that the data we hold about you will be processed lawfully and fairly. It will be accurate, relevant and not excessive. The information will be kept up to date, periodically reviewed as to the need to hold same, not retained for longer than is deemed necessary for the purpose for which it is being held and securely disposed of when no longer required for that purpose. It will be kept securely to prevent unauthorized access by other people.

You may request details of personal information which we hold about you and you may ask us to stop processing your data at any time.
