General

Continue to pray for the redevelopment of our Centre. The men on site have faced some challenging issues; pray for wisdom for ongoing decisions, and for safety and stamina for each of the workers.

Give thanks for the men who have just completed the Sycamore Tree programme. Pray that what they have learned will have a deep impact in their lives and in the lives of those affected by their crimes.

Give thanks for good relationships with the management of the prisons. Prison Fellowship is well received, and they are positive to see our programmes up and running again. Pray we will 'step up' to what we can do and for our witness to be 'seen and heard'.

Thank God for the churches that support our work with prayer, donations, and volunteers. Ask God to continue to open new doors in this area.

Family

Give thanks for the provision of children's books of the Easter Story, and the prayer group that made this possible. Please pray for each child and family who receive the books, that they will know how much they are loved by God and come to know Him.

Pray for restoration of relationships within families. Pray for a willingness to engage with 3rd parties, trained in reconciliation.

B has just come through Covid and self-isolation. Pray for him as he recovers. Give thanks he is mobile again - pray for him as he tries to go back to church and sort his benefits out.

Please pray for L. He is struggling with mental health and getting the right support. Pray others will not take advantage of him.
