Pray for R who has experienced a huge disappointment. She is doing really well, but potentially this could set her back. Pray for strength and healing.

Two women known to Lynne have died recently, both drugs related. It is incredibly sad and there are so many more fragile lives who simply need the transformation only He can bring.

A few of the women have now increased contact with their children. Pray these times will be incredibly special and healing.

P has moved into a new house. She says it's a fresh start for her. Pray it would be exactly that, and that addiction wouldn't take hold again.
