Gift Aid

If you are a UK taxpayer, you can increase the value of your gift by allowing Prison Fellowship Northern Ireland to claim back the tax you have already paid on your gift.

"I want to Gift Aid my donation and any donations I make in the future or have made in the past four years to Prison Fellowship Northern Ireland. I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less income tax in the current tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on my donations it is my responsibility to pay any difference."

Gift Aid is claimed by Prison Fellowship Northern Ireland from the tax you pay.
