General

Give thanks for the appointment of a new PF worker for HMP Maghaberry. Pray for Michael as he settles into this new role.

Pray for the continued challenge of increased numbers within our prisons. Pray for prison staff and management as they seek to provide and support.

Give thanks for donations received so far for Christmas Hope. Pray that once again sufficient toys, groceries, and finance will be provided so that we can meet all the requests from the prisons.

Please pray as we seek to appoint three posts within the PF Centre- Centre Coordinator, Administration/ Donor Care, and a Communications Worker. Pray for wisdom, and for the people of God's choosing for these key roles.

Staff are speaking in 9 churches this month. Give thanks for these opportunities and for the commitment of churches to support PF's ministry financially, in prayer and with volunteers. Ask that God would strengthen these church relationships.

Family

Give thanks for the conversations when phoning families about the hampers and toys. Pray for these conversations and any follow up, which takes place before and after Christmas.

Pray for the ongoing review of Family Work as the team seek to build on what is already happening. Pray for the Lord's guidance and inspiration.

Worry is a big issue for the family of those in custody, and many often say that they are worried all the time. Pray for peace and especially that God will give His peace.

Pray for God's awakening in the hearts and minds of many we work with, who do not know God.

We thank God for the opportunities He gives the family workers, Sandra, and Claire, to walk alongside and support the families of those in custody. Pray for God to direct their steps towards those who most need support and to give wisdom in every situation and conversation.

Volunteer
