Pray for A. He is receiving treatment for a medical condition and finds it very difficult to leave his home. He is very isolated and has very little support or Christian friendship where he lives.

W. was the victim of bullying and harassment in his accommodation. Please pray for him and his friend as the authorities deal with this. Pray for protection and help to cope at this stressful time.

Pray for Christmas Dinner this year. Many families and released prisoners struggle at Christmas time. Please pray for the men and women to come and hear the true Christmas message of Emmanuel.
